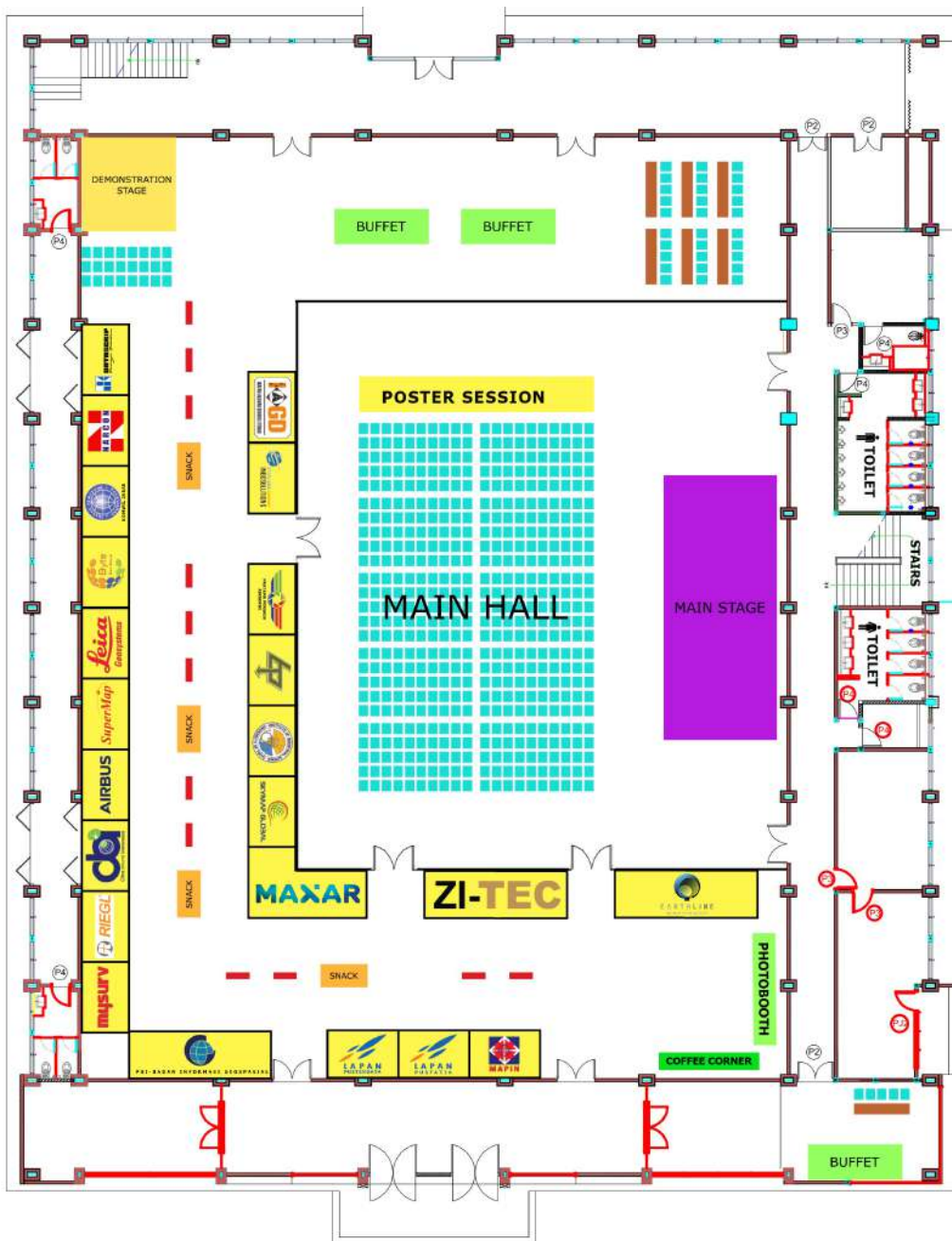

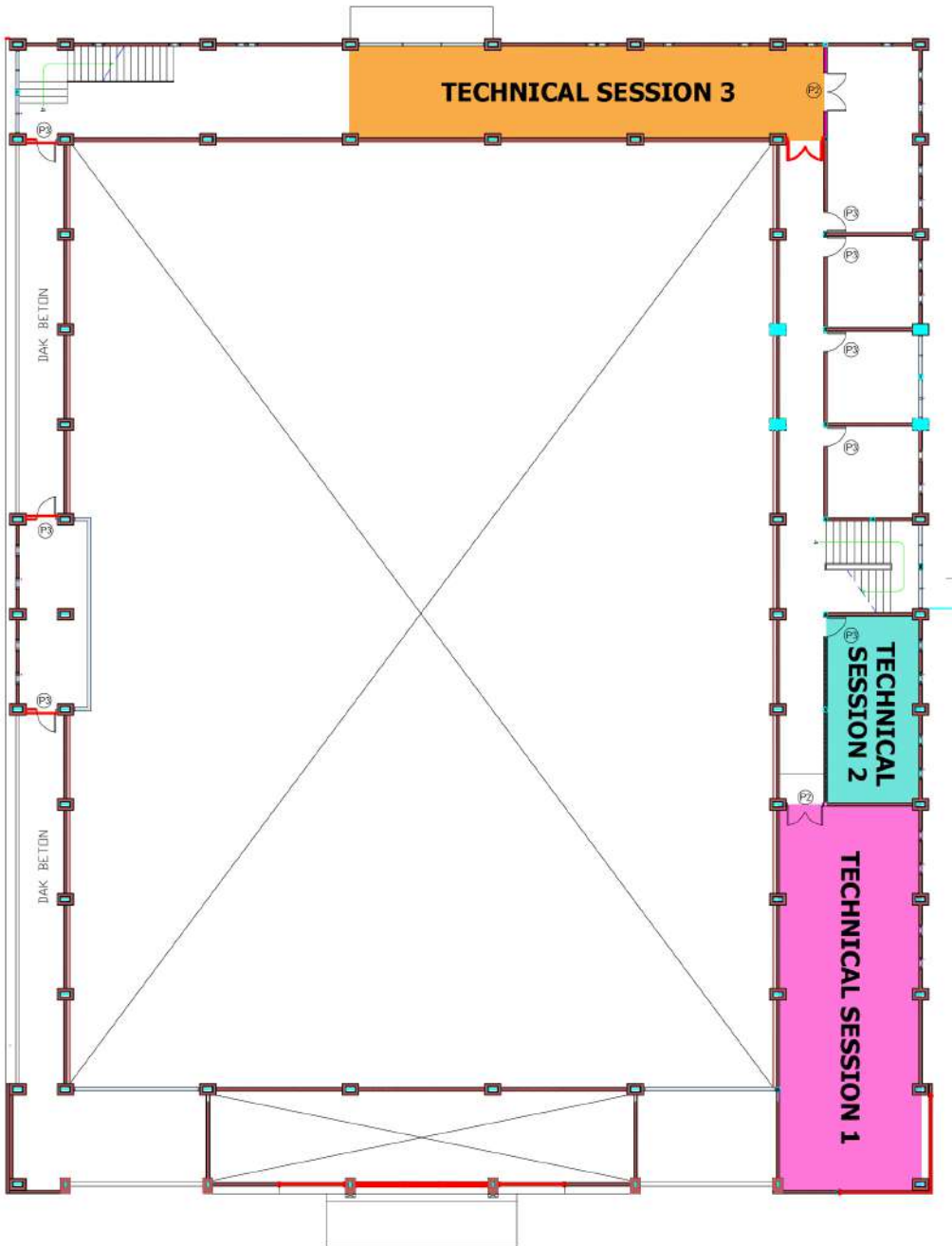


FLOOR PLAN

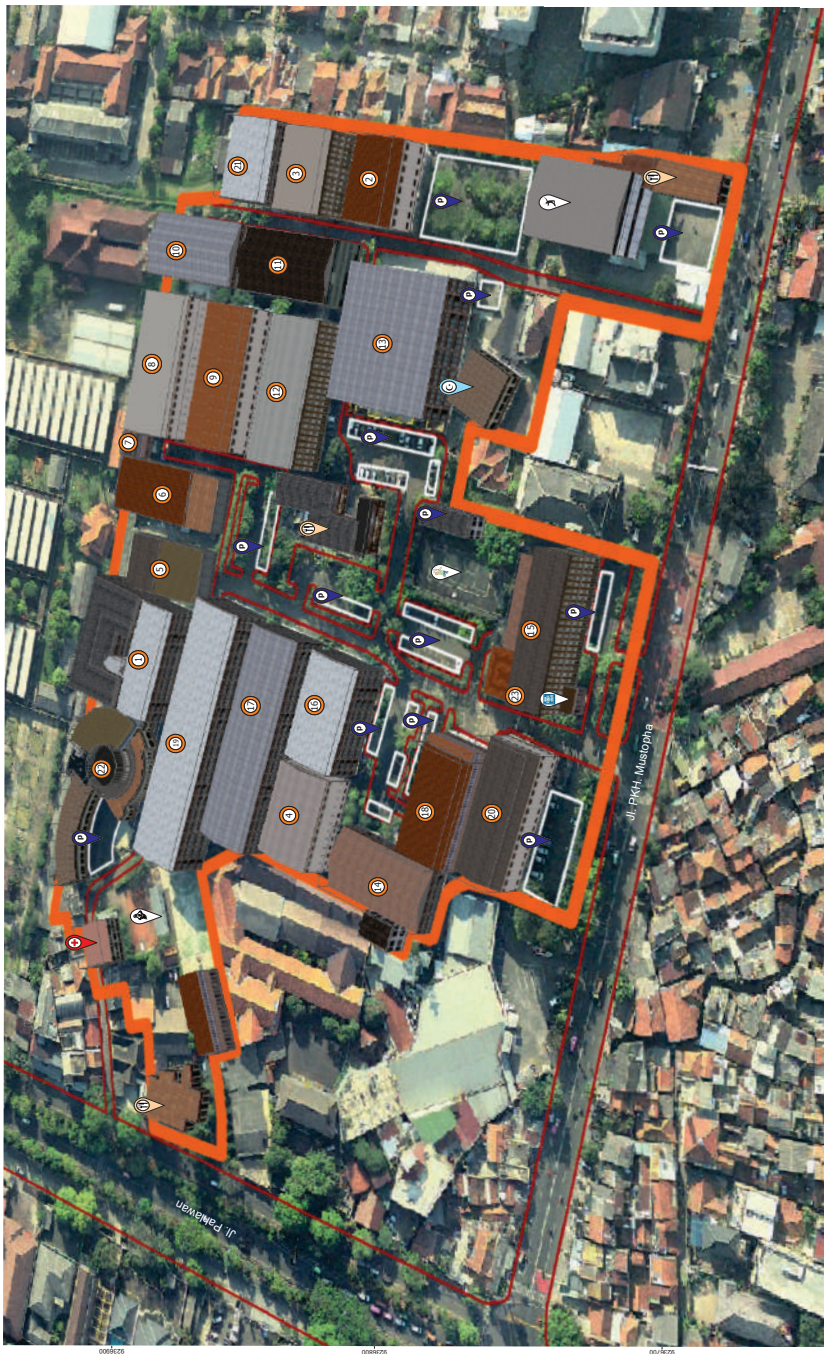
FIRST FLOOR

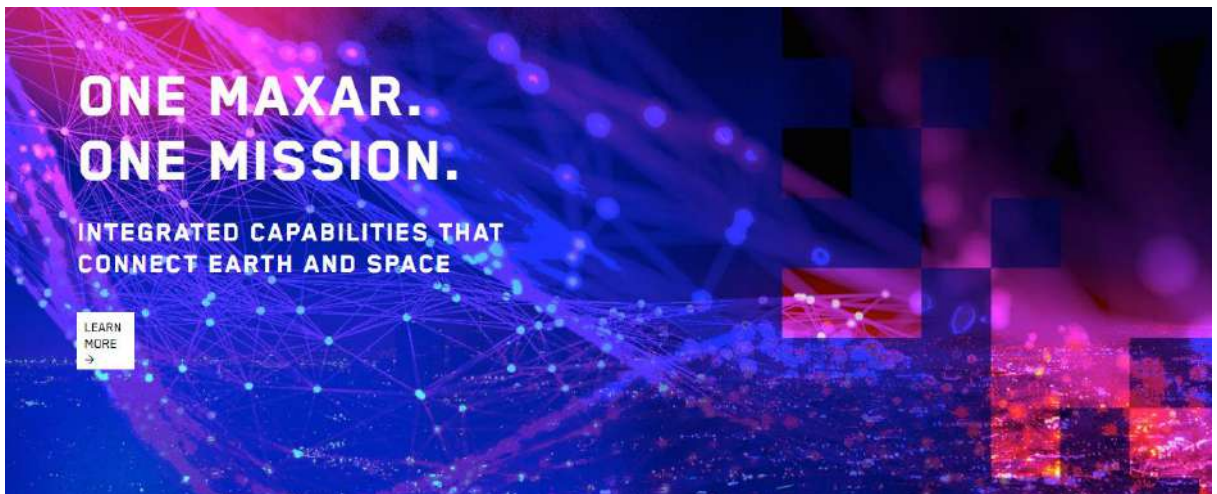
